By Car:

From Waterloo

Distance: 59 km

Time: 1hr depending on traffic

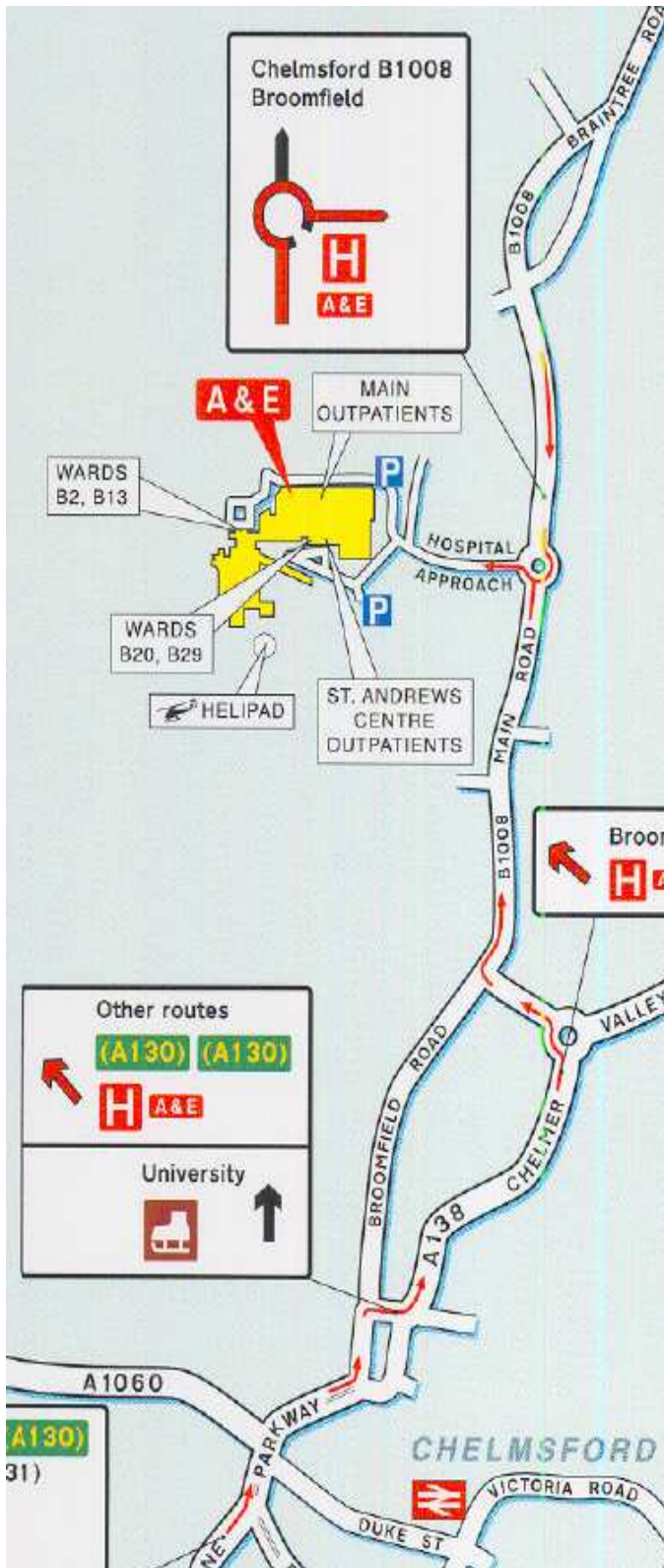
- On leaving Elizabeth House, take the 3rd exit at the IMAX roundabout (Waterloo Rd).
- At St George's Circus turn left (Borough Rd), then turn left onto Borough High Street
- Continue over London Bridge taking the right fork A3 (Gracechurch Street).
- Take right at traffic lights onto Fenchurch Street.
- Once at Aldgate follow A11 (signposted Newmarket) until Bow tube station
- At Bow Interchange turn left onto A12.
- Stay on A12 for (passing Greenman Roundabout, Newbury Park) approx 24km
- At junction 15 branch left and 1st main exit A414 onto A1016. At the next roundabout take second exit A1114 following signs to Town Centre
- B1008 following signs to Broomfield Hospital.

Public Transport

By Tube / Train - From Waterloo:

- From Waterloo, take the Jubilee line tube to Stratford.
- At Stratford station, change to a main line train to Chelmsford, direction: Braintree (journey time: 30 mins).
- On exiting Chelmsford train station, turn right and make your way to the bus station.
- Bus nos.: 16, 33 & 42 will take you directly to the hospital.

By Train:

There are also regular rail services from Chelmsford Town Centre to stations between London Liverpool Street and Ipswich.

By Bus:

Bus links to the town centre also cover some major local residential areas.

No.16 – Wethersfield, Stebbing and Felsted.

No.33 – Great Waltham, Great Dunmow and Stanstead Airport.

No.47 – Direct service to the Woodhall Estate, Melbourne, Springfield Park and Chelmer Village.

No.42 – Galleywood.

No.52 – Pleshey and Little Waltham.

No.344 (Off peak only) – Black Notley and Terling.

No.352 – Braintree and Halstead.
